## Stonybrook Trunk Storm Sewer Improvement Project

### **Project Schedule**

We received bids and will be recommending an award to the City Council on May 14 for the project.

It is anticipated the contractor will begin construction as soon as early June.

The work will include a new 60" storm pipe with new inlets, street restoration, sanitary sewer main replacement, and miscellaneous utility maintenance along Craigbrook Way and crossing Alden Way. The 60" storm pipe will cross over East River Road as well.

In addition to the Stonybrook Trunk Storm Sewer Improvement Project, minor preventative maintenance work will be taking place on the existing watermain. This work will start on Thursday, May 3<sup>rd</sup> and will take a couple of days.

In June, our contractor is expected to start clearing select trees along with pavement and curb removals and preliminary utility work. Note the schedule is tentative and subject to change. There will be periods of limited access that you will be notified of as a schedule is developed. The City will send additional notices as the work commences. Future project updates will provide more specific dates.

### **Are you interested in repairing your water/sanitary service or do you have other work, such as driveway repair planned?**

The project will include replacement of some water services and sewer services within the road right-of-way. If you have need, the City is putting together a list of residents that are interested in extending sewer or water service repair within your property to help coordinate these repairs during the project. If you would like your sewer service televised from your house to the right-of-way, please contact us as soon as possible (the City is extending this service to you free of charge). Due to the short timeframe, the City may be able to assist you with financing of needed service repairs. If you are planning on repairs to your driveway please let us know. We advise you to share any other work you have planned with us.

Please notify us if you have an event this summer such as a graduation party, family gathering, house for sale, etc. We will do our utmost to accommodate your needs and provide adequate access to your home.
