Stonybrook Trunk Storm Sewer Improvement Project

Project Awarded!

On May 14, 2018, the City Council awarded the Stonybrook Trunk Storm Sewer Improvement Project to Peterson Companies of Chisago City, MN. Peterson Companies provided a bid below estimate and within the project budget. Work will be phased by the contractor, with anticipated completion by end of July (Weather Dependent).

Project Schedule

It is anticipated Peterson Companies will begin construction in the next week or two. As previously noted, the work will include a 60" Storm Sewer pipe, pavement rehabilitation and resurfacing, concrete curb, sanitary sewer replacement, and miscellaneous utility replacement. Sanitary sewer replacement will be replaced from East River Road to Alden Way. Additionally, CenterPoint Energy gas main and service replacements are going to be taking place while the project will be going on this summer.

Peterson Companies is going to start bringing traffic control devices and start clearing some trees at the end of this week at the earliest. Staff will be marking the trees that are going to be removed with a big "X" sometime this week as well. All trees that are going to be removed will be on the north side of Craigbrook Way and will be replaced with new ones by the City.

Note the schedule is tentative and subject to change. There will be periods of limited access that you will be notified of as a schedule is developed. The City will send additional notices as the work commences. Future project updates will provide more specific dates.

Are you interested in repairing your water/sanitary service or do you have other work, such as driveway repair planned?

The project will include replacement of some water services and sewer services within the road right-of-way. If you have need, the City is putting together a list of residents that are interested in extending sewer or water service repair within your property to help coordinate these repairs during the project. If you would like your sewer service televised from your house to the right-of-way, please contact us as soon as possible (the City is extending this service to you free of charge). Due to the short timeframe, the City may be able to assist you with financing of needed service repairs. If you are planning on repairs to your driveway please let us know. We advise you to share any other work you have planned with us.

Do you have an event planned?

Please notify us if you have an event this summer such as a graduation party, family gathering, house for sale, etc. We will do our utmost to accommodate your needs and provide adequate access to your home.

Safety

We ask that you please not leave any cars on the street during the duration of the project. It causes delays for our contractor and we don't want to cause any damage to your personal vehicles. Please remember to be safe and drive cautiously wherever you see construction warning signs and cones. Follow detours carefully. Do not approach machinery when in operation.
