Street Reclaim

The contractor will be starting Reclaim work on the streets in your area beginning on Saturday, June 2nd. The work will take place on Craigbrook Way and Alden Way. Cars cannot be parked on these streets during this work. **Please have all parked cars off of the street prior to Saturday, 7:00 AM.** The contractor will be posting “No Parking” signs along the street to remind you that there will be no parking allowed on the street starting Saturday morning.

After the reclaim machine goes through, the contractor will grade the road so that traffic will be able to commute the roadway. After reclaiming the pavement, there will be a gravel road during the construction of the utilities. The contractor will be placing water on the road periodically to keep the dust down and will be maintaining the gravel road to avoid holes and hazards in the roadway.

The schedule above is weather dependent. The schedule will be shifted back given poor weather conditions. The City will send additional notices as work commences. Please note some residents are receiving these notices as it relates to construction traffic and accessing your street.
