Stonybrook Trunk Storm Sewer Improvement Project

Water Service Disruption

As a part of this Project, the water services from the water main to the curb stop will be replaced for the properties on the **north side of Craigbrook Way**. To accomplish the work, homes along these alignments will be connected to a temporary water system. Monday, June 4th, the Contractor began laying pipes on the ground in front of your home and connected the temporary service to your home through the outdoor hose spigot.

The Contractor will require access to the shut-off valve located in your home. **Please call Clint at 651-775-4161 to schedule your shut off.** The typical hours to schedule access are 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM. You will be notified when the temporary water service will be activated. Please note the temporary water system is sampled and tested per the Minnesota Department of Health's standards prior to activating. It is likely the temporary connection will be activated Monday, June 11th. The contractor will need access to your shut-off valve again after reconnecting your regular water service to the new watermain.

Access

Our contractor has been told that they need to allow access for residents to get through the construction area throughout the day. We are working on the mail service (Might possibly set up temporary mailboxes at a best fit location) and our contractor is taking your garbage/recycling cans to a spot where garbage/recycling trucks are able to get access to.

Safety

We ask that you please not leave any cars on the street during the duration of the project. It causes delays for our contractor and we don't want to cause any damage to your personal vehicles. Please remember to be safe and drive cautiously wherever you see construction warning signs and cones. Follow detours carefully. Do not approach machinery when in operation.
